

COFRA COOKIES AND PRIVACY POLICY

This Cookies and Privacy Policy relates to the following website: www.cofraholding.com and sets out the basis on which any personal data COFRA Holding AG, Zug ("COFRA", "us", "we" and /or "our") collects from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. We are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected, so please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

Information (personal data) we collect from you

We may collect and process the following information (personal data) from you:

- information that you email to us using mail@cofraholding.com or the contact form on our homepage
- if you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence; and
- details of your visits to our website and the resources that you access.

Our use of your personal data and other information

We use the personal data you provide in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. If you provide personal data for a certain reason, we may use the personal data in connection with the reason for which it was provided. For instance, if you contact us by email, we will use the personal data you provide to answer your question or resolve your problem. We may also use the personal data and other information you provide in connection with your use of our website to help us improve the content and functionality of the website and to better understand our users.

If at any time you wish to review your personal data or have your personal data deleted, please contact us as indicated below. If we intend to use any personal data in any manner that is not consistent with this Privacy Policy, you will be informed of such anticipated use before or at the time at which the personal data is collected.

Our disclosure of your personal data and other information

Information is normally provided to a third party only if it is required to deal with your enquiry. However, there may be other circumstances where we are required to provide information to comply with any legal or regulatory obligation or request. We do not undertake marketing activities for third parties, nor do we provide information to third parties for their own marketing purposes.

How we protect your data

The security of your personal data is important to us. We follow generally accepted standards to protect the personal data submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is completely secure, however. So though we will do our best to protect your information, we cannot ensure the security of your data transmitted to our website. Any information you submit is sent at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to prevent unauthorised access.

We take all reasonable care to ensure the security of the website and of your personal information from access by unauthorised persons and against unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction

and damage. We will not share your information other than as provided for in this Cookies and Privacy Policy or as required by law, by court order or by other government or law enforcement authorities.

IP addresses and cookies

Cookies are small pieces of data used to store information on web browsers and to store and receive identifiers from computers, phones and other devices. Our website makes minimal use of cookies. The cookies we use help us understand how visitors use our website (what is the most popular content, number of visitors, their geographic location, etc.) and to generate statistics. This helps us to better understand our website visitors and to use that knowledge to improve the website. For this, we use Google Analytics. Analytical cookies provided by Google Inc. are placed on our website. Based on the data collected by these cookies, Google prepares anonymous reports for COFRA relating to the use of our website. Cookie usage

The cookies used by this website to deliver the Google Analytics service are described below. These cookies are of two types: functional cookies (which are required for proper use of the website) and analytical cookies (which analyse how you use our website). Functional cookies can be read only by COFRA employees authorised to do so. COFRA does not share such data with external parties unless it is authorised to do so.
